- Breast care nurse specialist
- Breast surgeon or consultant

CoppaFeel! welcomes applications from black, asian and minority ethnic candidates, LGBTQ+ candidates, candidates with disabilities, and from men, because we would like to increase the representation of these groups within the charity.

We want everyone to have the best possible chance of surviving breast cancer.

Ideally, we want to live in a world where all breast cancers are diagnosed at the earliest stage possible, at which treatments are more effective and survival rates are higher.

Although our main focus is on breast cancer education, we also instigated the #RETHINKCANCER Campaign, as we strongly believe young people should be taught about *all* cancers and how to lead healthy lives from a young age.

The team and founders, although experts in talking to young people about boob checking, are not medically trained. The Medical Advisory Group aims to support the CoppaFeel! team in reviewing, developing and informing all health messaging, materials and campaigns.

Roles and Responsibilities

The principal role of the Medical Advisory Group is to advise the charity on medical and clinical approaches to the following topics:

- Breast cancer
- Cancer
- NHS services and approaches
- Political strategies concerning health in general and more specifically cancer.
- PHE services and approaches
- Cancer education

In addition, matters will also be referred to the group from the CoppaFeel! team with regards to the charity's campaigns and activities where we feel it is appropriate.

All members will be expected to:

- Attend meetings and calls, unless communicated to CoppaFeel! team in advance.
- Respond to requests for further support on referred matters outside of meetings.
- Represent CoppaFeel! in the media when agreed and arranged by the charity and MAG member.
- Highlight any opportunities or contacts that could be beneficial for CoppaFeel! in the health sector.
- Review and provide feedback on any draft documents or materials sent to the group by the CoppaFeel! team.
