ABOUT COPPAFEEL!

CoppaFeel! exists to educate and remind every young person in the UK that checking their chests could save their life.

We are the first breast cancer charity in the UK to solely create awareness amongst young people, with the aim of instilling the knowledge and tools they need to get to know their bodies. We like to talk about a serious message in a light-hearted way, empowering people to start healthy habits for life.

OUR VISION

We want everyone to have the best possible chance of surviving breast cancer. Ideally, we want to live in a world where all breast cancers are diagnosed at the earliest stage possible, at which treatments are more effective and survival rates are higher. Although our main focus is on breast cancer education, we also instigated the #RETHINKCANCER Campaign, as we strongly believe young people should be taught about all cancers and how to lead healthy lives from a young age.

OUR MISSION

To ensure all breast cancers are diagnosed early and correctly by:

- Encouraging you to check your chest regularly from a young age
- Educating you on the signs and symptoms of breast cancer
- Empowering you to seek advice from a doctor if symptoms persist

ABOUT THE EDUCATION ADVISORY GROUP

The Education Advisory Group was set up in 2018 to add an extra layer of expertise to the growing team. CoppaFeel! was born from a determined, enthusiastic group of young people who wanted to make a real change. The team and founders, although experts in talking to young people about chest checking, are not trained in the education field. The Education Advisory Group aims to support the CoppaFeel! team in reviewing, developing and informing all health messaging, resources, programmes, materials and campaigns.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The principal role of the Education Advisory Group will be to advise the charity on Educational approaches to the following topics:

- The Boobette Programme
- Cancer education, resources and schemes of work
- Education partnerships
- Political strategies and changes generally, more specifically education and cancer
- PSHE/RSHE services and approaches
- Introduce appropriate contacts and/or opportunities
- Promotion in the education sector

There will be the opportunity to run initiatives and test materials in your daily role/workplace if suitable. The group will also consider any other matters referred to them by the board of trustees or CoppaFeel! team.

ALL MEMBERS WILL BE EXPECTED TO:

- Attend meetings and calls, unless communicated to CoppaFeel! team in advance
- Respond to requests for further support on referred matters outside of meetings
- Represent CoppaFeel! in the media when agreed and arranged by the charity and Education Advisory Group
- Highlight any opportunities or contacts that could be beneficial for CoppaFeel! in the education sector
- Review and provide feedback on any draft documents, resources or materials sent to the group by the CoppaFeel! Team
- Familiarise yourself with the charity's current campaigns and areas of work. We recommend visiting our website and reading our latest annual report.

COPPAFEEL! WILL ENSURE:

- Members are only contacted about appropriate and necessary matters
- Meetings will be scheduled as far in advance as possible to allow time for members to confirm the meeting/calls in their diaries
- Members will have the opportunity to write articles for the CoppaFeel! Brazette and appear in social media features / takeovers
- All members are invited to CoppaFeel!'s thank you party to celebrate their contribution to the CoppaFeel! Community
- Travel expenses will be covered for members to attend meetings and any other events on behalf of the charity, as agreed with the CoppaFeel! Team. A travel expense form will be provided after events
- Group members have input to how the group is developed.
