

CoppaFeel! Fundraising Feedback Form

Prize Draw

1. By entering the 'CoppaFeel! Fundraising Survey' prize draw you are agreeing to these prize draw terms and conditions.
2. The prize draw is being run by CoppaFeel!.

Eligibility to Enter

3. The prize draw is open to UK-only entrants who have completed the CoppaFeel! Fundraising Survey.
4. In entering the prize draw, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the prize (see section 10). CoppaFeel! reserves the right to check your eligibility before entering you into the draw.
5. A maximum of one entry per individual per year is permitted.
6. The prize draw is free to enter.
7. All entrants must be 18 or over.

How to Enter

8. To enter the prize draw, you will need to have engaged with CoppaFeel! by ordering a community fundraising pack during October 2024.
9. By completing the CoppaFeel! Fundraising Survey form and by giving your contact details via the form you will be in with a chance of winning. Once you have submitted the prize draw form you will then be entered into the draw.
10. To be entered into the draw, you must complete the CoppaFeel! Fundraising Survey by 28th March 2025.
11. You will be entered into a prize draw, which will take place on 2nd April 2025.
12. CoppaFeel! will not accept responsibility if the contact details provided are incomplete or inaccurate.

The Prize

13. You will be able to win one of the following:
 - a. One Love2shop voucher to the value of £20.
 - b. One of three copies of Glittering a Turd by Kris Hallenga.

14. The voucher is the first prize. A winner will be selected for this prize first. The book is the second prize. Subsequent winners will receive this prize. Winners cannot choose which prize they'd like to receive.
15. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternatives will be offered.
16. We reserve the right to substitute prizes with another prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond our control make it necessary to do so.
17. The decision of CoppaFeel! regarding any aspect of the prize draw is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.
18. The winners will be drawn at random from all valid entries and recorded via Zoom with an independent observer present. This recording will not be shared publicly but retained as proof that the prize was allocated by chance.

Winner Announcement

19. The winners will be notified on 3rd April 2025 via the contact details provided on the form submitted.
20. CoppaFeel! will attempt to contact the winners by email once.
21. If the winner does not respond to the email notifying them of their win within 7 days of the first email attempt, they will lose their right to the prize, and CoppaFeel! reserves the right to choose and notify a new winner.

Receipt of the Prize

22. On acceptance of the prize, CoppaFeel! Will:
 - a. Send you the gift card via email.
 - b. Send you the book via post.
23. If you win one of the books, CoppaFeel! will cover the cost of postage to an address of your choosing. This will be discussed on acceptance of the prize.

Data Protection and Publicity

24. You consent to any personal information you provide in entering the prize draw being used by CoppaFeel! for the purposes of administering the prize draw, and for those purposes as defined within our privacy policy.
